THE NINETEENTH CENTURY PAPACY

2 credits

Tuesday 6:40 – 8:35 p.m.

This course explores the evolution of the papacy in theory and practice from the aftermath of the French Revolution until the First World War. Attention is given to such diverse topics as Napoleon and the French Concordat of 1801, the rise of Ultramontanism and Liberal Catholicism, the Revolution of 1848, papal responses to modernity, the First Vatican Council and the loss of Papal temporal power, the French Third Republic and the Ralliement, and the Modernist crisis.
